Rick Batalia as Aegisthus, burns the stage up with the song "Watch Out", Katherine Donahoe is terrific as Cassandra, slave of ABBAMEMNON, Joseph Keane as the Herald who carries a spear like no one else can, and Monica Schneider is classic as ABBAMEMNON's wife Clytemnestra. Tyler King as a Soldier, Rob Nagle as Thyestes, Suzanne Jolie Narbonne as Penelope, Darrin Revitz as Iphigenia,

Mike Sulprizio as Calchas, Patrick Toth as a Watchman, and Jason Turner as Menelaus round out a remarkable cast full of talent. Last, but definitely not least, is Matt Walker as ABBAMEMNON, who also directed this great group of talented actors, and who is truly amazing and an authentic presence on stage.

The voices, the dancing, stage movement, puppets, costumes, lighting, set, props and group of talented musicians playing each wonderful musical number, give us a thoroughly enjoyable evening of theatre.

The Troubies, and **ABBAMEMNON** are wonderful silliness. It's fun, hysterical, clever, memorable, MUST SEE silliness. You will sing along to "Dancing Queen", and laugh yourself silly! Ha!
