Complete cast announced for Church & State

Producers of the New York premiere of **Church & State**, a comedy written by Jason Odell Williams and directed by Markus Potter, have now announced complete casting and creative team for the upcoming production.

Joining previously announced **Rob Nagle** (as Senator Charles Whitmore), will be **Nadia Bowers** (Sara Whitmore), **Christa Scott-Reed** (Alex Klein) and **Jonathan Louis Dent** (Tom/Marshall).

Previews begin at off-Broadway's New World Stages on March 3, 2017, before an official opening on March 20.

Synopsis: "Church & State is a comedy about faith, politics, and 'The Twitter.' It's three days before Charlie Whitmore's Senate reelection and he's decided to finally tell the public exactly what's on his mind, no filter. What could possibly go wrong?"
