THE HOTHOUSE - Antaeus Theatre Company, through March 11

The Hothouse may be one of Harold Pinter (/people/Harold-Pinter/)'s lesser-known plays but it still comes packed with the playwright's signature wit and punch. Here, he examines the rampant abuse of power at an institution rife with moral ambiguity, through a Theatre of the Absurd lens. The dialogue-heavy language play exposes the complicated inner workings of human thought, which is often as poignant as it is ridiculous. All Antaeus productions are partner cast so check the website for dates if you want to see a specific group of actors. At this performance, "The Ducks" cast included Peter Van Norden, Graham Hamilton, JD Cullum, Rob Nagle, Paul Eiding, John Apicella , and Jocelyn Towne, a particularly seasoned ensemble that delivered the play's message with chilling intensity.
